2. The students may draw a picture if desired on a separate sheet.
3. The poems will be reviewed. The volume of poems received and the length of the poem will dictate how many can be posted on the website for 1 week. At the end of the week, a new group of poems will be posted on the site. In the beginning, this will not be a contest. The primary goal is to encourage our children to write

and feel good about being published writers! The contest may be considered in the future.

4. There will be separate pages for the elementary and secondary poetry.
